## STITCH GUIDE

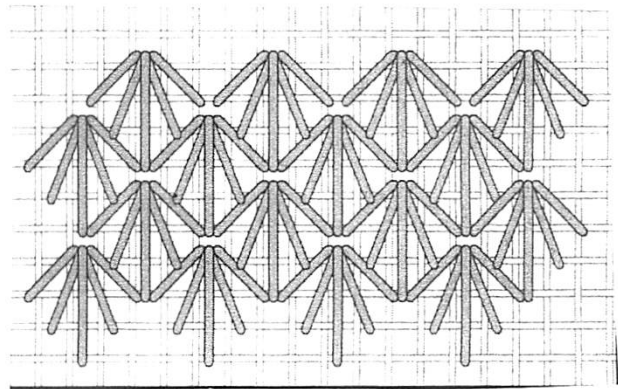
## JANUARY HALLOWEEN – VIGGO THE VULTURE

I am not sure why I needed to start with a vulture – but he insisted.

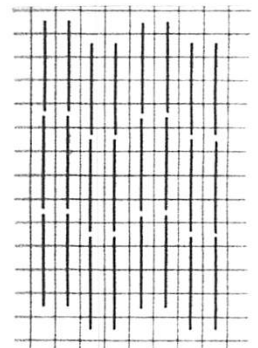
We'll start with the easy part all in basketweave. First stitch the eye and the beak with the Snow called Midnight. Because of the hints of blue. Next stitch his pink head with vineyard. Finally stitch the body with fuzzy stuff.

Around the neck and legs, couch Baby Fluffy Fleece with white wool or just thread.

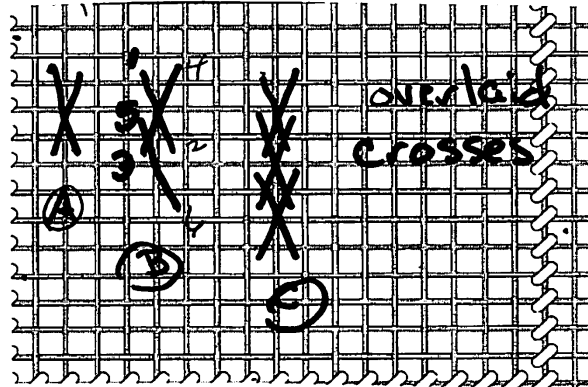
Wing – use the DIAMOND RAY stitch. You will have to “fudge” at the bottom.



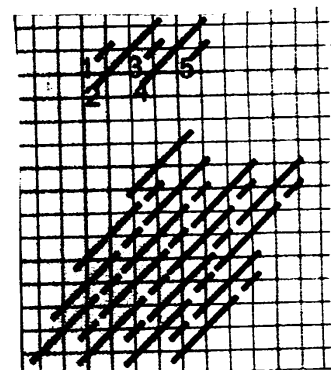
Tail – use the DOUBLE BRICK stitch for the tail



Legs – do staggered crosses down both legs. Stitch “stem stitches” away from the legs over the painted parts for the talons.



Background – NOBUKO. We have made a variation to the Nabuko. The long stitches are in Vineyard Silk, the short stitches are in a metallic. It is easier to do the entire row of long stitches first, skipping the small. Go back and fill in the small, then drop down to do the next row of long and so on.



Hopefully, we'll be ready with some of these finished by Halloween – a spooky thought.
