



STITCH GUIDE

FEBRUARY HALLOWEEN CAT ON PUMPKIN

This is a simple little fellow. I wish I could make him "scarier" but I am too much of a cat lover.


CAT: cross-stitch the eyes in green Vineyard silk, and stitch the mouth and nose with red and gray perle. Use the BRICK stitch for the body of the cat, use LONG STITCHES to fill in the tails of the cat following its contours, and stitch the face in basketweave – all using the Angora. It will be a little thick for the face, but it still works.





PUMPKIN: Stitch the face with black metallic and the pumpkin lines with orange Vineyard silk. Take the sections of the pumpkin one at a time. First, pad each section with perle cotton – first horizontally and then vertically. Finally, go back

and stitch horizontally using either Neon rays + or Petite Sparkle Rays.



Finally, use the TRIPLE CASHMERE stitched vertically for the

background.
